### REQUIREMENTS:

The West Windsor Bicycle and Pedestrian Alliance (WWBPA) will award up to \$1,000 (no more than \$500 per student) in scholarship funding to one or more students. Applicants must be seniors and residents of West Windsor or Plainsboro and attend West Windsor-Plainsboro High School North or South, or be West Windsor residents who attend another area private school or are home-schooled, and must complete their high school education by June 2010.
